BEGINNING TO TAKE SHAPE

- Strategic areas of focus included Rider Safety, Advocacy and Government Relations, Strategic Communications/Outreach, International Relations & Competition.
- Key goals included improved communications, establishing MCC as the go-to motorcycling resource, May as National Motorcycle Awareness Month, and a socio-economic study on motorcycling benefits.
 • Recognizing the need for visibility, MCC developed a Communications
- Plan and an online repository for motorcycling content.
- Two Women's Conferences (2010 and 2013) were organized to grow
- and promote women in motorcycling.

 MCC hosted "Day on the Hill" in Ottawa in the past to promote motorcycle safety with the federal government.

THE ECONOMIC IMPACT OF MOTORCYCLING

2014+

- Engaged members and the motorcycling community through a new website, quarterly newsletters, and monthly blog articles as part of the Communications Plan.
- Commissioned the "Recreational Motorcycling in Canada and its Provinces 2014-2040" study to analyze the economic impact of motorcycling nationwide.
- · Continued the National Safety Campaign, designated May as Motorcycle Safety Awareness Month, received official recognition in the House of Commons, and introduced the Motorcycle Safety
- Executed an annual campaign that reached over 200,000 Canadians in 2017 to promote motorcycle safety for both on-road and off-road riders nationwide.

2024 & BEYOND

- · Reimagining our website & social media strategy, enhancing SEO and online visibility.
- · Introducing an Adventure Council, alongside our existing On Road, Off-Road, and Competition Councils, dedicated to advocating for and enhancing the experience for the rapidly growing community of adventure motorcyclists.
- · Revamping our beginner-friendly off-road Safety Training into "Off-Road Motorcycling 101", complete with a fresh logo and an updated manual for instructors.
- · Completing our socio economic study first ever for motorcycles and confirmed the importance of motorcycling to the Canadian economy ready to be released in early 2024.
